RESOLUTION ADOPTING UPDATES TO THE LARIMER COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Larimer County, Colorado (hereinafter referred to as "County") has the statutory responsibility to develop, implement, and maintain an effective emergency management plan under C.R.S. 24-33.5-707 (8); and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the need to have a coordinated approach to major incidents and disasters that affect the area; and

WHEREAS, the County has established an Office of Emergency Management to oversee and complete emergency management functions for the county, in cooperation with municipalities, special districts and non-governmental partners, and

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Management has prepared the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan in accordance with state and federal requirements and guidance, which is made up of multiple parts or sub-plans; and

WHEREAS, the County has previously adopted the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and has adopted updates from time to time as necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Management has updated two parts of the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, specifically Part 3: Emergency Operations Plan and Part 4:Disaster Recovery Plan, which are attached as Exhibits A and B respectively and incorporated by this reference; and

WHEREAS, all agencies and departments having responsibilities contained within the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, including the above-mentioned updated Parts 3 and 4, have acknowledged and agreed upon their roles and responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby adopts the updated Parts 3 and 4 of the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan which, together with the remining and unchanged parts of said plan will serve as the statutorily required emergency management plan for Larimer County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of Emergency Management will continue to administer and monitor the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and provide revisions and updates to the Board as needed to remain current.
