<p><b>Prepare Public Education &amp; Resource Clearinghouse</b></p> <p>Identify and support programs and ideas to improve public water education and create a helpful resource center for residents on the county website.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Identify staffing resources to support expanded water education on sources, rights, and conservation.</li> <li>Offer field trips, fire-water education, and conservation materials, and host water quality events at County parks and open spaces.</li> <li>Consider continuing the Water Education Series and supporting other education efforts.</li> <li>Create an interactive map of water providers and guide the public to local conservation resources, including information for newcomers on the County website.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Address Water Efficiency in Disproportionately Impacted Communities</b></p> <p>Identify opportunities to address disproportionately impacted communities through education and water efficiency programs.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Collaborate on efforts in incorporated areas and help to coordinate initiatives in unincorporated Larimer County.</li> <li>Promote existing programs to offer discounted or free water fixture upgrades to reduce resident water bills.</li> </ul>
